As a result, subconsciously she is missing her home planet an awful lot. When She returns to earth to find the moon destroyed and everyone dead, it sends her over the edge and causes her to start hallucinating. Earth has become another empty planet to collect samples from, just like all the others.

Bea's reflection is a more human version of herself. Bea's reflection has emotions and is the regret Bea subconsciously feels for turning herself into a machine. She is curious and theologically challenging about the existence of herself and also android Bea. Her sole objective is to persuade Isaac to rid himself of his man made immortality and become mortal again.
